Worship Team Member Role

Worship teams play a very important role in the weekend services of our church as they use their musical gifts from God to facilitate corporate, musical worship. Team members work together under the leadership of a volunteer team leader who is led and supported by the Pastor or overseer.

Worship Team Member Responsibilities

Worship team members are expected to:

- Come to each worship service they lead on time and prepared to the best of their ability
- Come to rehearsals on time and prepared to play their role to the best of their ability
- Practice their instrument as needed outside of rehearsals in order to support the team
- Submit themselves to the spiritual, musical and administrative leadership of the volunteer worship team leader
- Give the volunteer worship team leader as much notice as possible when they will not be able to participate in rehearsal or in leading during a worship service
- Seek the help of their volunteer worship team leader with any needs in regard to their involvement with worship

Requirements for Worship Team Members

- Be an active pursuer of God through the ministries of our church
- Actively going through discipleship.
- Go through Worship Team Member Training with a volunteer worship team leader
- Be able to commit to serving on a worship team for a minimum of 3 months
- Be willing to abide by the On-stage Guidelines
